

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

# U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

In the U.S. cash cattle trade on Friday was fairly active with dressed deals ranging from \$180.00-\$188.00, mostly \$182.00-\$183.00 which is up \$2.00-\$3.00 from the previous week. A few live sales in the north were from \$114.00-\$117.00 also up around \$2.00 from last week and at a premium over the south. In the south late Friday afternoon a light to moderate trade was reported from \$111.00-\$112.00 live, also up \$2.00-\$3.00 from the previous week, while live head to a premium over the south. In the south late Friday afternoon a light to moderate trade was reported from \$111.00-\$112.00 live, also up \$2.00-\$3.00 from the week before. Overall for the week, the Mandatory Price Report lists live steers averaging \$113.38 up \$2.13 from the previous week, while live heifers averaged \$112.84 up \$2.02. On the rail steers averaged \$182.87 and heifers \$182.91 dressed, both averaging \$2.78 stronger than the previous week. Today, the market was quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is mixed, with volumes in Texas lower, while most other feeding states have a larger offering this week. Asking prices and bids are both unestablished today.
