ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested, however some scattered trade could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: "Technical price levels have eased from since Monday. There have been rumblings packers are trying to pull some August contracts ahead of schedule." Asking prices are reported around \$250.00-\$252.00 delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was light this morning in the south at \$111.00 live, steady to \$1.00 lower than last week. A light test in the north was steady to last week at \$114.00 live and \$183.00-\$185.00 dressed. Active trade is not expected to develop before tomorrow with asking prices sitting at \$114.00 live in the south and \$186.00 plus dressed in the north.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 326 head on offer, in 3 lots with delivery in 1-9 or 1-17 days. Asking prices on all lots were at \$111.00 live and all three lots sold for \$111.00, which is around \$2.00 below last week's weighted average prices.
