ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested, however some trade could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax reports: "Technical price levels are unchanged from Monday. Fed cattle supplies remain ample and by the sounds of things there could be a few more September fed contract numbers compared to August. Seasonally fed prices trend lower over the next 30 days. Reported cash sales have been somewhat light over the past three weeks and there is a feeling producers are fighting the market." Canfax notes that asking prices are around the low 240's delivered.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Tuesday saw a few cattle trade in the north from \$108.00-\$110.00 live which is steady to last week, while a few deals on the rail were reported from \$172.00-\$174.00 dressed , down \$2.00 from last week. Today, bids surfaced in the south at \$101.00 live, down \$5.00 from last week's market, while bids in the north were at \$175.00 dressed which is steady to last week, however no trade has been reported at this time. Asking prices are sitting at \$108.00 live in the south and \$180.00 dressed in the north. Active trade is not expected to develop today.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 734 head on offer, in 5 lots. Three lots in the south were asking \$105.00-\$106.00 but received no bids. Two lots in the north with delivery in 1-17 days were asking \$106.00 live, with both lots selling at that price which is easier than last week's northern trade.
