



## ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** remained untested. Canfax reports today: "This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes steady with the previous week Last week on a cash to cash basis Alberta fed prices were at a 3.00 premium against the Nebraska market. Cattle feeding margins have been negative for the better part of the last sixteen months Cattle being sold today could be losing close to 300.00/head. On a more positive note Canadian beef exports from January to July are up 14.5% in volume and 24.2% in values compared to last year."

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of hundred head trade in the north yesterday at \$101.00-\$102.00 live and \$160.00-\$162.00 dressed which is up a couple of dollars from last week but not nearly enough to establish a market. Today, the market was very quiet with no bids on the table and asking prices unestablished. Today's cattle futures increases will likely encourage sellers to push asking prices higher this week. Yesterday a smaller offering was reported, however that was changed to larger this morning due to cattle being carried over from last week. Active trade is not expected to develop today.
