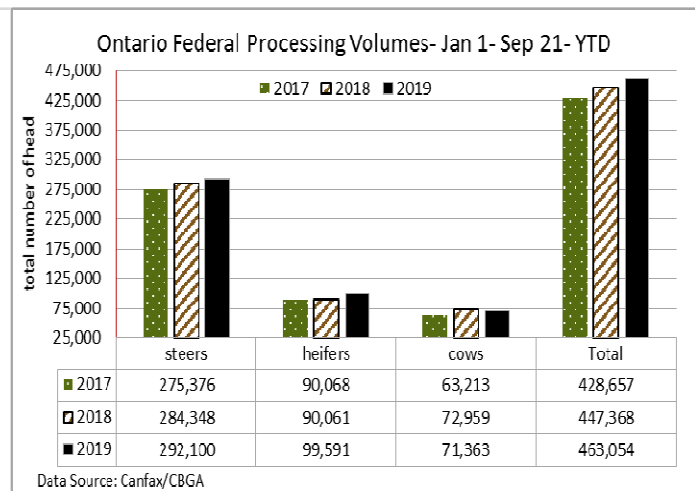
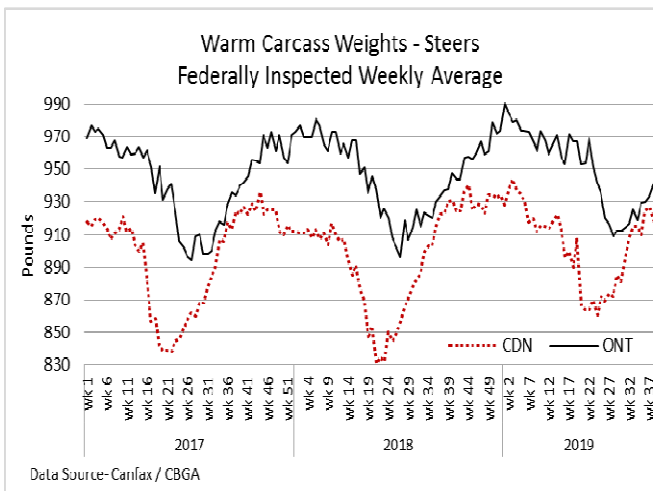

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Friday saw trade develop in the south from \$102.00-\$103.00 live, mostly \$103.00 up \$2.00 from the previous week. In the north, trade was noted as stronger than Thursday, with sales from \$106.00-\$107.00 live, up \$4.00-\$5.00 and \$165.00-\$167.00 dressed, mostly \$165.00. Overall, for the week, prices reported by the USDA Mandatory Price report listed live sales from \$102.00-\$107.00 with steers averaging \$104.93 up \$3.01 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$104.62 up \$3.04. On the rail trade ranged from \$162.00-\$167.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$165.29 up \$2.82, while heifers averaged \$165.14 up \$2.27.

Today, the market was very quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported to be larger in volume in the south and smaller in volume in the north. Active trade is not expected to develop until the second half of the week.
