ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday remained untested, however business is expected to develop this afternoon. Canfax noted bids at \$240.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "Technical price levels have improved since Monday. With stronger prices in the US late last week, Alberta fed prices did move to a discount against the US market. Based on the five year average basis levels historically weaken from September to October. One positive for the fed cattle market is the fact non-fed slaughter volumes have been slow to increase. For the fed cattle market steady to higher prices are expected for this week."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade today is seeing bids in the south at \$105.00 live which is up \$2.00 from last week's average, while bids in the north are sitting at \$107.00 live, steady to the top of last week's northern trade, but no sales have developed at this time. Asking price are reported at \$108.00 live in the south and \$175.00 plus dressed in the north.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 846 head on offer, in 4 lots with delivery in 1-17 days for two lots in the north, and 1-9 days on two southern lots. One lot in the north was asking \$111.00 live while the remaining three lots on offer ranged from \$106.00-\$107.00 live, with no bids offered and all cattle left unsold.
