U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was light to moderate on Friday with live sales in the south from \$106.00-\$107.00 up \$3.00-\$4.00 cwt, while dressed deals were from \$169.00-\$170.00, mostly \$170.00 up around \$5.00 from the previous week. Trade overall for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, listed live sales from \$104.00-\$109.00 with steers averaging \$107.30 up \$2.37 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$107.88 up \$3.26. On the rail prices ranged from \$162.00-\$171.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$169.79 up \$4.50 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$169.79 up \$4.65.

Today, the market was very quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering larger in Texas, smaller in Kansas and somewhat smaller in the north. A few northern asking prices have been noted at \$112.00 live but for the most part, bids and asking prices remain unestablished.
