ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Tuesday remained at a standstill, however some business could start to develop this afternoon. Canfax notes asking prices from \$245.00-\$250.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reported: "Technical price levels have improved since Monday. This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. It sounds like at least one western Canadian packer will operate on Saturday to make up for the Thanksgiving Day holiday."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle was at a standstill today with just a couple of bids in the north at \$172.00 dressed, with no sales reported. Asking prices are sitting at \$111.00-\$112.00 live in the south and \$180.00 dressed in the north. Active trade is not expected to develop before Thursday at the earliest.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today there were 768 head on offer, in 5 lots with delivery in 1-9 days on 4 southern lots and 1-17 days on one northern lot. All five lots were asking \$111.00 live, but packers showed no interest and all lots were left unsold.
