ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remained untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax reports: "This weeks showlist has been be compiled with volumes larger than the previous week. Last week on a dressed basis Alberta fed prices were at a 6.00 premium against the Ontario market. Canadian beef cutout values are trading 1 to 5% higher than last year while fed cattle prices are 5-7% below last year. In other words, packers are buying cattle cheaper than last year and are selling the beef at higher prices year over year. Suggesting packers are profitable."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains very quiet with no bids were on the table and asking prices generally unestablished, with just a few lots in the south asking \$110.00 plus live. Active trade is not expected to develop before Wednesday at the earliest.
