



U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was stronger in the south with prices ranging from \$109.00-\$112.00, mostly \$110.00 up \$2.00 on average. Business in the north was steady with a few live sales at \$109.00-\$110.00, while dressed deals ranged from \$171.00-\$176.00, mostly \$175.00. Prices overall for the week, listed by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live trade range from \$108.00-\$112.00, with steers averaging \$110.13 up \$0.40 and heifers \$110.03 up \$0.39. On the rail, trade ranged from \$171.00-\$176.00 delivered on a dressed basis, with steers averaging \$174.56 up \$0.25 and heifers \$174.97 up \$1.37.

Today, the market was very quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported to be larger in volume in all feeding states, with the exception of Kansas which has fewer cattle on offer. No bids have surface at this time and asking prices are undefined, but are expected to be higher than last week.
