ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remained untested. Canfax notes that asking prices are around the mid 240's delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was quiet today just a couple of starter bids noted in parts of Nebraska at \$181.00 dressed which is steady to last week, but no trade has developed. Asking prices are sitting at \$118.00 live in the south and \$185.00-\$188.00 dressed in the north. Active trade is not expected to develop until the second half of the week.

Business last week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report listed live sales from 113.00-\$118.00 with steers averaging \$114.60 up \$1.57 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$114.66 up \$1.63. On the rail, steers and heifers sold from \$177.00-\$185.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$181.04 up \$1.65 while heifers averaged \$181.92 up \$2.75 from the previous week on average.
