ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade saw a light test on Monday with Canfax reporting prices up \$5.00 from last week at \$272.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax notes that: "this week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. Packers seem to be scrambling for short term inventory, in some instances cattle are being lifted 1-2 weeks ahead of schedule."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains untested today with active trade not expected to develop until Thursday or Friday, after the Christmas holiday. A couple of deals were noted by Canfax in the U.S. at \$121.00 live, steady to last week, but not enough to establish a market. Asking prices are sitting at \$123.00 live in the south and \$195.00 dressed in the north.
