

Fed steers and heifers on Ontario farms totaled 385,700 head on January 1, 2020, down 10,000 from 2019 and 20,800 fewer than on January 1, 2018. The steers were the lowest volumes since January 1, 2016 while heifer volumes were up from January 1, 2019 and the largest January 1<sup>st</sup> volume since 2014.






A light run due to severe winter weather saw calves and yearlings trading actively at steady prices.



Replacement heifers on Ontario farms as of January 1, 2020 totaled 43,100 head which is the largest January volume since January 1, 2016. Beef cow volumes on Ontario farms were also higher with the January 1, 2020 volume sitting at 253,900 head, up 6,900 from 2019 and is the largest January head count since January 1, 2015.



Replacement cattle volumes on Ontario farms as of January 1, 2020 is sitting at 407,400 head, down 23,800 from 2019 and 15,500 below January 1, 2018. This is the lowest January 1<sup>st</sup> replacement cattle volume since the beginning of data collection in 1932.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was under pressure last week with prices declining slightly as the week progressed. Live trade started out from \$116.00-\$119.00 but by Friday sales ranged from \$112.00-\$113.00. The USDA Mandatory Price report listed live steers at \$114.85 on average, down \$4.86 while heifers averaged \$114.74 down \$4.93 from the previous week. On the rail, trade started the week at \$187.00 dressed but by Friday prices had dropped to \$178.00-\$182.00 dressed. For the week, steers averaged \$184.78 down \$5.29, while heifers averaged \$184.75 down \$5.39 from the previous week on average.

Today, the market was very quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as larger in volume in the north and slightly lower to lower in the south. Bids and asking prices are currently unestablished, with little business expected to develop before the second half of the week.
