ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains unstested. Canfax reports that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume with asking prices in the upper 250's delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a light test yesterday in parts of the north at \$115.00 live up \$2.00-\$5.00 from last week's trade, and \$185.00 dressed up at least \$10.00 cwt from last week but not enough to establish a market. Cattle futures also closed limit higher yesterday resulting in expanded limits today of 4.50 for the live contracts and \$6.75 for the feeders. This morning the futures opened up the expanded limits on most contracts, and held there the remainder of the day. A few sales in parts of the north today were noted at \$186.00 dressed, up another dollar from yesterday but again, not enough to establish a market. Asking prices are sitting at \$125.00 live in the south and \$190.00-\$195.00 dressed in the north. Active trade is not expected to develop before the second half of the week.
