ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with no bids reported at this time. This week's offering is reported by Canfax as smaller than last week in volume, with asking prices in the low to mid 240's delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports that reduced processing at one Western packer will limit buying interest in the cash market this week.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals in the north yesterday from \$154.00-\$155.00 delivered on a dressed basis, down \$10.00-\$12.00 cwt from last week but not enough sold to establish a market. Yesterday, the cattle futures were down the limit, resulting in expanded limits today of 4.50 on the live cattle and 6.75 on the feeder cattle. Thankfully futures headed in the right direction today.

On the cash market today, trade was quiet with no bids reported. A couple of lots in the south have been priced at \$108.00 cwt live, otherwise asking prices are undefined.
