ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was light on Wednesday with prices reported by Canfax from \$187.00-\$225.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reported: "Sales are 7.00-45.00 higher than last week. The one packer that is bidding 225.00 delivered is limiting the volume of cattle that they are buying from producers. One major packer is still not bidding on the cash market this week. With reduced slaughter volumes and idle plants over the past few weeks it is estimated we have over 100,000 head of cattle backed up in western Canada."

The U.S cash cattle trade was light to moderate yesterday with southern trade reported from \$110.00-\$115.00 live which is stronger than last week's average prices by \$5.00-\$10.00, but steady to last Friday's trade. In the north dressed trade ranged from \$168.00-\$185.00 which is steady to Tuesday but considerably higher than last week's average prices. Today, the market is very quiet following two days of trade. Asking prices on the remaining cattle are set at \$115.00-\$120.00 live in the south and \$185.00 plus dressed in the north.
