ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade on Wednesday was reported as higher with Canfax noting: "Wednesday saw active trade with dressed sales averaging \$14-15/cwt higher than the previous week. The majority of sales were at \$255/cwt delivered for June delivery while some \$230/cwt delivered has cattle scheduled for July. Total Western Canadian slaughter for the week ending May 30th was 28% larger than the previous week at 46,600 head."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S cash cattle trade was light to moderate so far this week with prices ranging anywhere from \$110.00-\$117.00 on a live basis and \$173.00-\$187.00 dressed. As of Wednesday night, the USDA Mandatory Price Report lists live steers at \$114.47 on average and heifers \$114.46 down \$1.00-\$2.00 from last week. On the rail steers are averaging \$180.52 and heifers \$181.94 down \$3.00 from last week on average. Today, a couple of deals in Kansas are noted at \$105.00 live, down \$10.00 from last week's weighted average price, but receipts are very light. Otherwise, bids and asking prices are few and far between today with just a couple of bids in the north at \$175.00 dressed, while the rest of the country is very quiet.
