The U.S. cash cattle trade was light yesterday with southern deals reported from \$98.00-\$100.00 live, while business in the north was reported from \$100.00-\$105.00 live and \$158.00-\$167.00 dressed. Sale were around \$3.00-\$6.00 cwt lower than last week. Today, a light test in Nebraska is noted at \$158.00 dressed, steady to the bottom of Monday's trade but down \$8.00 from last week's weighted average prices. Business appears to be following the same trend as the last couple of weeks with a light trade developing each day. Asking prices are siting at \$108.00-\$110.00 live in the south and \$170.00 plus dressed in the north.
