U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was steady to \$1.00 stronger on average. Lives sales reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report for the week ranged from \$93.00-\$102.00 live, with the bottom of the range in the south and the top of the range in the north. Live prices for steers averaged \$97.24 up \$0.88 from the previous week while heifers averaged \$96.71 up \$0.98. On the rail prices ranged from \$155.00-\$161.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$158.10 up \$0.54 and heifers \$157.94 up \$0.42.

Today, the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and this week's show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as smaller in volume in all feeding states with Texas reporting the largest decline. Asking prices are poorly defined with just a few lots in the north priced at \$102.00 live and \$162.00 dressed. Active trade is not expected to develop until Tuesday at the earliest.

The U.S. July 1st Cattle Inventory Report released on Friday, was as expected with the total inventory up just slightly from July 1, 2019. Beef cow inventories were down 1% and calf crop inventories were also down 1%. All other classes were steady in volume to 2% higher, which was anticipated due to the backlog resulting from the Covid19 shutdowns.
