ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested. Bids are reported as steady to last week while asking prices are sitting around \$230.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Some trade could start to develop this afternoon. Canfax reports: "Backlogged fed cattle supplies are being widdled down, over the past six weeks almost 24,000 head more fed cattle have been slaughtered versus last year. One packer is lifting cattle very timely."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a good number of cattle sell on Tuesday in the south from \$95.00-\$97.75 live, which is anywhere from \$1.00 lower than last week's southern trade, to \$1.0 higher on average. Today, a light trade has surfaced with business in the south at \$97.00 live, up \$1.00 from last week, while sales in the north are sitting at \$160.00 dressed, up \$2.00 from last week on average. Asking prices are reported at \$98.00-\$100.00 live in the south and \$162.00 plus dressed in the north.

At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today, there were 1,507 head on offer, in 9 lots all from the south, with delivery in 1-17 days. Asking prices ranged from \$97.00-\$98.00 live, with seven lots selling from \$97.00-\$97.50, which is up \$2.00 from last week's online prices. Two lots received no bids.
