U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week was stronger with live trade reported by the USDA Mandatory Price report from \$100.50-\$106.00 live, with steers averaging \$103.54 up \$2.33 and heifers \$103.33 up \$2.17 from the previous week's weighted average. In the north dressed trade was reported from \$160.00-\$165.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$163.25 up \$2.59 and heifers \$163.04 up \$2.60.

Today the market was very quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as lower in most feeding states, with just Texas noting slightly smaller volumes. Bids and asking prices are unestablished today with little trade expected to develop before Wednesday.
