ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade is quiet. Canfax reports: "this weeks showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. For the week ending October 10th western Canadian steer carcass weights increased 14lbs to average 956lbs. This is the largest carcass weight on record. Based on USDA import data, it is showing a few more Canadian fed cattle are being shipped South into the US for slaughter. Most of the cattle being shipped south are contract cattle."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a decent volume sell yesterday in parts of the south with sales from \$103.00-\$106.00 live, majority at \$106.00 down \$2.00 from last week on average. A few sales in the north were also noted yesterday from \$164.00-\$166.00 dressed, mostly \$165.00 which is down around \$3.00 from last week. Early week trade was sparked by extremely lower cattle futures yesterday and this morning started out with continued pressure. But, by noon the downward pressure reversed and futures were a little stronger today in most contracts. On the cash market today a light test was noted in Kansas at \$106.00 live, steady to yesterday while the other feeding states resisted bids of \$104.00 live and \$166.00 dressed. Asking prices are poorly defined with just a few southern lots priced at \$108.00 live.
