Alberta direct trade remains very quiet with no trade reported. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw around 300 head trade yesterday in lowa at \$164.00 dressed, up \$2.00 from last week but not enough sold to establish a market. Word is that packers are short bought this week due to light purchases last week, however packer interest so far is limited with no bids on the table today. Asking prices are unestablished at this time but are expected to be upwards of \$110.00 live in the south. Not much was expected to happen today as the U.S. focuses on the Presidential Election. Sellers are expected to hold out for higher prices this week which could delay trade until Thursday.
