ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested however some scattered deals are possible this afternoon. Canfax reports asking prices sitting at \$232.00-\$235.00 delivered on a dressed basis. US packer interest is expected to be minimal due to the Holiday in the states.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals late Tuesday at \$110.00-\$111.00 live and a few at \$171.00-172.00 dressed, but not enough to establish a market. This morning a light trade has surfaced in the south at \$110.00-\$111.00 live, steady to \$1.00 higher, while bids in Nebraska are at \$110.00-\$111.00 live up \$1.00 from last week, and \$174.00 dressed up \$2.00, but no sales have been reported. Sellers are holding out for stronger prices with asking prices in the south holding firm at \$112.00 plus live. Asking prices in the north are poorly defined. If packers want to get business wrapped up today ahead of Thanksgiving, they are going to have to push bids a little higher. At the Fed Cattle Exchange online auction today, there were 782 head on offer, in 4 lots with delivery in 1-17 days. Three lots sold from \$110.75-\$111.00 live up \$0.50-\$0.75 from last week's online market. One lot received no bids. Choice and Select Steers and Heifers: Live 110.75-111.00 Rail N/T
