ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested however some light trade could start to surface this afternoon. Canfax note that asking prices are holding firm at \$245.00-\$247.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis which is up \$3.00-\$5.00 from last week's trade.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains untested so far today with just a couple of bids surfacing in parts of Nebraska at \$175.00 dressed, but no trade has developed. Asking prices are reported at \$114.00 plus live in the south and \$180.00 plus dressed in the north. Active trade will likely be delayed until Thursday or Friday.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1,142 head on offer, in 8 lots with asking prices set at \$109.00 live on all lots while reserved bids were from \$113.00-\$114.00. Only one lot sold of 42 head, at \$112.00 live which was below the reserve bid, but the seller took the bid. All other sellers passed bids of \$109.00-\$112.25 live.
