#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade was reported as active on Wednesday with sales reported from \$243.00-\$245.00 delivered on a dressed basis, up \$1.00-\$3.00 cwt higher than last week. Live trade was also noted by Canfax at \$143.00-\$147.00 on a picked up basis, with prices steady to \$4.00 cwt higher than last week's market. Business is expected to continue today with delivery of this week's trade scheduled in one to two weeks.

#### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S cash cattle trade saw a few deals yesterday at \$112.00 live which is steady to last week but not enough sold to establish a market. Today, a couple of sales were noted in lowa at \$177.00 dressed, up \$2.00 from last week while the rest of the country is untested. A couple of bids in Nebraska are reported from \$175.00-\$176.00 dressed, steady to last week but no trade has developed. In the south packer interest has yet to surface with no bids on the table. Asking prices are reported at \$114.00-\$115.00 live in the south and \$180.00 plus dressed in the north.
