### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** was reported by Canfax as steady to last week with sales at \$255.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax also reported some live trade from \$150.00-\$150.50 on a picked up basis which is also fully steady to last week.

### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

**The US cash cattle trade** was reported as scattered to light yesterday with live trade ranging from \$111.00-\$115.00 live, mostly \$114.00 which is steady to last week. A light test in the north was noted from \$178.00-\$180.75, majority at \$180.00 dressed which is steady to \$1.00 stronger than last week on average. Today, a couple of deals in Nebraska are noted at \$113.00 live, down \$1.00 from Wednesday but steady to last week's northern trade. Bids in the north are sitting at \$178.00-\$180.00 dressed but sellers are not showing any interest. The south is quiet with no bids on the table. Business is expected to develop in all areas, especially the north, later today and into Friday. Asking prices are holding firm at \$115.00-\$116.00 live in the south and \$185.00 plus dressed in the north.
