

### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested so far this week with asking prices reported by Canfax around \$260.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. This week's offering is steady to last week in volume. Packer interest should start to improve this afternoon. Canfax reports: "This fall and early winter, feedlot conditions have been ideal, last week was the first true blast of winter to set cattle back and limit weight gains. In general, 7-10 days of cold temperatures should not have a major impact on carcass weights."

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals yesterday at \$114.00 live which is fully steady to last week, but trade was limited. Today, the market is very quiet with no bids on the table and little trade expected to develop before Thursday or Friday. Asking prices are reported at \$116.00-\$117.00 live in the south and \$188.00 plus dressed in the north. Many feeding states are dealing with unusual harsh winter weather causing distruptions in transportation and power outages resulting is delays at processing facilities, with two plants in the south having to close for a couple of days due to the weather. Producers are struggling to keep up with chores as the weather continues.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today there were 1,444 head on offer, in 9 lots with delivery in 1-14 days with minimum bids set at \$113.00 live. No sales developed as bids were below reserve bids of \$113.50-\$114.50. Another sale is scheduled for tomorrow.
