U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live prices range from \$118.00-\$122.50 with steers averaging #119.92 up \$0.28 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$119.90 up \$0.14. On the rail trade ranged from \$188.00-\$194.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$190.68 down \$0.01 and heifers \$190.75 up \$0.18.

Today, the market was quiet as both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as slightly higher in Kansas and higher in all other feeding states. No bids have surfaced and asking prices are unestablished at this time. Agcenter.com notes: "JBS announced the lost output from early last week will be replaced by week's end leaving some room for optimism."
