ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta's direct trade this week held steady at \$276.00-\$277.00 delivered on a dressed basis noted Canfax. On a picked-up basis prices were reported at \$163.50 live for steers averaging \$1.69 lower than last week, while on the rail prices ranged from \$272.00-\$275.00 dressed, with steers averaging \$274.07 down \$0.45 and heifers \$275.25 up \$0.52 from the previous week on average. Canfax reports: "Most of the cattle that traded were being scheduled for the week of July 12th delivery. Historically when Alberta fed prices are at such a premium to the US, western Canadian packers start to scale back hours. This has not been the case this time, instead there has been talks of adding a few Saturday shifts to the work week schedule. This week there were premiums being paid for export eligible cattle. This week's cash offering has been cleaned up."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade this week has been moderate to active with stronger prices for the first time in seven weeks. Sales started on Monday and continued through to Thursday with trade in the south from \$120.00-\$124.00 live, mainly \$122.00 up \$2.00 cwt. In the north trade was reported from \$192.00-\$200.00 dressed, mostly \$195.00 up \$4.00 from the previous week on average. Some clean up trade is possible but the bulk of trade for the week has been completed.
