ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested so far this week. Asking prices are sitting around \$282.00 or more cwt, delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports that this week's offering is larger than last week's in volume.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The **U.S. cash cattle market** saw some light trade develop yesterday. The USDA price report indicated that 3,043 head of live cattle sold, priced from \$125.00-\$126.50. On the rail, 470 head sold between \$195.00-\$200.00 dressed.

Today, the market was quiet. A few bids have surfaced in the north around \$125.00-\$126.50 live, and \$197.00-\$200.00 dressed. Asking prices have not yet been established in the North but asking prices have been reported around \$124.00 or higher, live in the South.
