ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested. Canfax notes that this week's offering is larger in volume than last week, with asking prices in the lower \$270.00's cwt delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade for last week, released by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live sales overall range from \$118.00-\$127.25 live with steers averaging \$123.89 down \$1.58 from the previous week, while heifers averaged \$123.46 down \$1.05. On the rail trade ranged from \$193.00-\$203.00 dressed with steers averaging \$198.27 up \$0.29 and heifers \$197.80 up \$0.58.

Today the market was quiet following yesterday's holiday Monday. This morning both sides took inventory and new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is larger in Texas and slightly higher in all other feeding states. No bids were on the table today and asking prices were unestablished. Business could develop as early as tomorrow.
