ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested however some trade is expected to develop this afternoon. Canfax notes: "Packers seem to have a lot of grid cattle around them. Last week packers were buying cattle for the first part of August, suggesting they have a high percentage of their July slaughter needs covered. Cattle weights are slowly creeping up. With this recent price pull back on the fed market feedlots have went from making a little bit of money to selling cattle at or below breakeven levels."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Tuesday saw a couple of scattered deals in the north from \$198.00-\$202.00 dressed which is steady to last week but not enough sold to establish a market. Today a light test has developed in in the south from \$120.00-\$122.00 live which is steady to last week. In the north a few sales have been reported at \$198.00 dressed, also steady. Packer interest is expected to improve later today and into Thursday. Asking prices in the south are noted at \$124.00 live while the north continues undefined.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today, there were 5,131 head on offer, in 33 lots with delivery in 1-17 days. Four lots sold from \$119.00-\$120.00 live, with only one at \$119.00. The remaining 29 lots were unsold as reserve prices from \$118.00-\$122.50 live were not met.
