#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume with asking prices around \$257.00-\$260.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "For the week ending July 10th Western Canadian fed slaughter totaled just over 48,000 head, the largest slaughter seen this year. From their lows in June steer carcass weights have increased 30lbs. Packers have a lot of cattle around them. Dry conditions has taken its toll on pastures. The yearling run is underway, yearlings coming off grass are moving 1-2 months earlier than normal."

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

**The U.S. cash cattle trade** saw a couple of deals yesterday in Iowa at \$125.00 live, fully steady but not enough sold to establish any kind of market trend. Today the market was at a standstill with no bids reported. Asking prices in the south are starting out around \$120.00 plus live while the north remains unestablished. Active trading is not expected to surface before Wednesday at the earliest.
