Alberta's direct trade was light with prices reported by Canfax at \$252.00 dressed on Wednesday to \$253.00 on Thursday for steers, on a delivered basis. Prices are reported as steady to \$4.00 cwt easier than last week's trade. Canfax reports: "Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the week of August 16th delivery. This is the 6th week in a row of lower fed cattle and butcher cow prices. Some fed cattle will be carried into next week."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was at a complete standstill today as business for the week has been completed. Business this week ranged from \$117.0-\$119.00 live in the south, mainly \$119.00 which is \$1.00 easier than last week. Sales in the north ranged from \$194.00-\$202.00 dressed, most at \$195.00 with a few at \$197.00 dressed, down \$1.00-\$3.00 cwt. A few sales on Thursday in Iowa were noted at \$125.00 live up \$1.00 from Wednesday, but trade was light. Agcenter.com reported : "Trading this week started much slower and the first cattle to sell were of somewhat lower quality. This was followed by late week prices where higher quality cattle sold yesterday up to \$125 in Iowa. Sellers with more desirable cattle were not ready to accept lower prices."
