The US cash cattle trade saw light activity Wednesday with live cattle trading from \$116.00-\$123.00 and dressed sales priced from \$195.00-\$201.00.

Today, light to moderate trade developed. Sales were reported from \$196.00-\$196.50 dressed, but mostly at \$196.00. Live cattle traded from \$120.00-\$123.00, with the majority of sales priced at \$120.00. According to DTN, dressed trade in the North is roughly steady to last week's weighted average basis Nebraska. Live trade in the south is roughly \$1.00 higher than last week's weighted averages. Asking prices are at \$122.00 or higher live in the south and \$200.00 or more dressed in the north.
