#### ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

**Alberta direct trade** remains untested however some business is expected to start to develop this afternoon. Canfax notes asking prices are around \$258.00-\$260.00 delivered. Canfax reports: "Packers seem well positioned with cattle. Feed grain prices continue to trade at record high levels and feedlots are dealing with cost of gains. With barley prices elevated and tough to find, some feedlots are feeding more corn, oats and other by-products as well.

## U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a few head sell in lowa Tuesday at \$127.00 live, stronger than last week but not enough to establish a trend. The rest of the country was quiet with no bids on the table. Sellers are current and are willing to hold out for higher prices, especially with the continuing stronger boxed beef prices. Trade volumes the last couple of weeks has been noted as light with reports that packers will need to purchase cattle this week, but are also reluctant to raise bids. Active trade could be delayed until Thursday or Friday as a result.

Today a light test is noted in the south at \$121.00 live, basically steady to last week's southern trade. A couple of deals in Iowa are noted at \$126.00 live with bids in Nebraska at \$198.00-\$202.00 dressed. Asking prices in the south are noted at \$123.00-\$124.00 live while the north remains unestablished.

At the Central Stockyards online auction today, there were 4,872 head on offer, in 32 lots with delivery in 1-15 days, all from the south. Only 590 head sold from \$120.00-\$120.50 live, with 143 scratched and the remaining 4,139 listed as unsold as reserve bids from \$122.00-\$124.00 live were not met.
