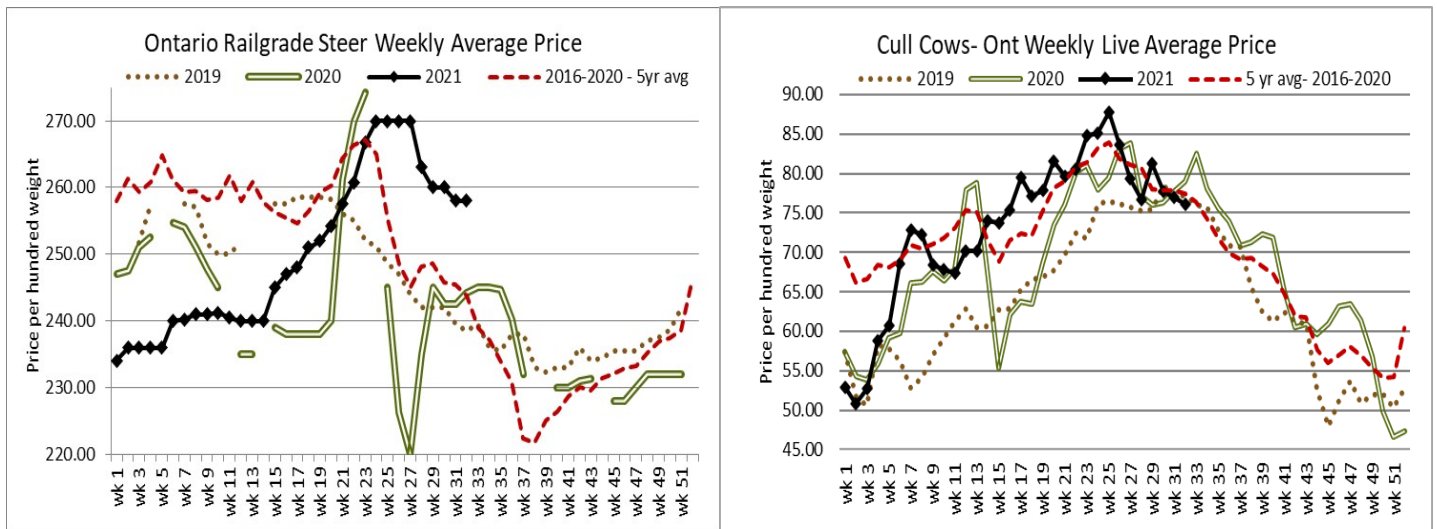
ONTARIO DIRECT TO PACKER RAILGRADE CATTLE TRADE

ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

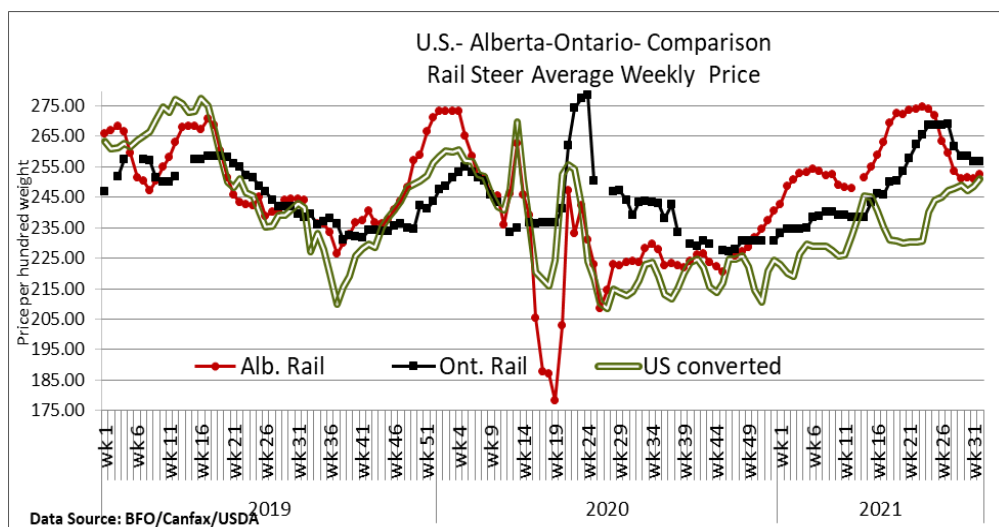
Alberta's direct trade this week was noted by Canfax as light with prices up \$1.00-\$2.00 cwt at \$254.00 delivered on a dressed basis. Canfax reports: "Most of the cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for the first half of September delivery. US buying interest on the Western Canadian fed market was non-existent. Fed cattle prices are higher than last year and higher than the five-year average, that aside feedlot margins are still negative. Sale volumes were light but cattle that needed to move were marketed this week to keep weights under control."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade this week was light to moderate with trade in the south reported from \$119.00-\$125.00 live, mostly \$121.00 which is fully steady to last week's southern trade. In the north trade was a bit lighter in volume as sellers held out for higher prices. Dressed deals ranged from \$197.00-\$204.00, mostly \$198.00-\$199.00 which is steady to slightly stronger. A couple of live deals early in the week in the north were noted at \$123.00 down from last week, but by Thursday trade was steady to last week at \$125.00-\$126.00 live. Today the market is quiet with no bids in the table. Asking prices on the remaining cattle are sitting at \$123.00 plus live in the south and \$200.00 plus dressed. Despite surging boxed beef prices sellers were unable push prices higher this week as anticipated, especially in the south.
