ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume with asking prices around the mid 260's delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Monday saw a couple of lots sell in the north at \$129.75 live and \$200.00 dressed, steady to \$1.00-\$2.00 stronger than last week's northern trade, but not nearly enough moved to establish any kind of market trend.

Today the market was very quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices are starting out around \$125.00 plus live in the south and \$202.00 plus dressed in the north. Little business is expected before Wednesday at the earliest. Live Cattle futures were stronger this morning but by afternoon the nearby live cattle contracts turned lower while the contracts further out held yesterday's gains and advanced slightly. Feeder cattle were under pressure as feed prices turned higher.
