Alberta direct trade was light to moderate yesterday with sales reported by Canfax from \$262.00-\$263.00 delivered on a dressed basis, up \$2.00-\$3.00 from last week. Canfax reports: "US buying interest on the Western Canadian fed market continues to be quiet. Fed cattle prices have strengthened for four straight weeks. From a seasonal standpoint the fed market has been impressive, this is usually the time of the year that fed prices are putting in annual lows."
