Alberta direct trade on Wednesday saw a few deals on a live basis at \$156.00 picked up which is steady to last week. Canfax notes that bids are steady from \$262.00-\$263.00 delivered on a dressed basis but no trade has surfaced on the rail. Canfax notes, "So far packers have bought very few cattle. With big slaughter volumes as of late, it does sound like lift times are starting to tighten up."
