

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw the majority of activity develop on Wednesday, last week. Overall, average prices for the week, as reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$123.88 down \$0.91, while live heifers averaged \$124.19 down \$0.06. On the rail, steers averaged \$198.64 dressed, down \$2.18, while heifers averaged \$198.82 dressed, down \$2.48.

Today, the market was quiet as both sides took inventory. According to Canfax, this week's offering is reported to be smaller in volume than the previous week in most major feeding areas. At the time of reporting, there were no bids on the table and asking prices were not established. Significant trade may be delayed until mid-week.
