



ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta's direct trade was light on both Wednesday and Thursday with prices reported by Canfax as steady from \$264.00-\$265.00 cwt delivered on a dressed basis. On a picked up basis steers averaged 262.85 dressed down \$0.66 from last week while heifers averaged \$262.67 down \$0.54 from last week. Canfax notes: "Cattle that traded this week were being scheduled for late October/early November delivery. All three western Canadian packers bought cattle this week."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade on Thursday saw live prices from \$120.00-\$124.00 live and \$192.00-\$196.00 dressed with sales mainly from \$194.00-\$196.00. Overall weekly prices seem to be down \$1.00 from last week on average. Some clean up trade is possible today, but it appears the bulk of business is completed. Asking prices on the few remaining cattle are sitting at \$124.00 plus live in the south and \$198.00 dressed in the north.

Agcenter.com reports: "Moving forward into October, the focus will be on weekly slaughter volumes. The past week was a disappointing 641,000 head and numbers this week will struggle to hold that number. Plant utilization or the ability of each plant to sustain the maximum slaughter capacity has been in decline -- suffering from labor problems, equipment failures and transportation glitches. Today through Saturday will need to ramp up to hold steady with last week's low slaughter number. Cattle futures fell again Thursday following lower revisions to this week's slaughter. Fears of a government shutdown that would stop mandatory price reporting, caused some end of the month liquidation."
