### U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week, was light to moderate with southern trade steady at \$124.00 live. Business in the north saw a wide range from \$193.00-\$198.00 dressed, mainly \$196.00 dressed which is steady, with some live sales averaging around \$124.50 up around \$1.00 from the week before. Overall average prices for the week, posted by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$124.39 up \$0.55 while live heifers averaged \$124.30 up \$0.45. On the rail steers averaged \$195.83 dressed, up \$0.13 and heifers \$195.99 up \$0.37.

Today was a typical Monday with show list distribution the business of the day. Bids and asking prices are unestablished at this time with little trade expected before Wednesday at the earliest. This week's offering is reported as slightly smaller in volume in the north and lower in the south. Friday's cattle on feed report saw placements lower than expected, which was supportive to the cattle futures today.
