ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is smaller than last week in volume with asking prices in the mid to upper 260's.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade saw a couple of deals in parts of the north yesterday at \$206.00-\$208.00 dressed, basically steady to last week but not nearly enough to establish a market. Today the market was quiet with little packer interest noted. Asking prices are sitting at \$134.00 plus live in the south while the north is unestablished. The Central Stockyards online action had a special sale Tuesday with 2,261 head on offer in 13 lots. Four lots sold from \$132.00-\$132.50 live, up \$1.00 from last week's sales, two lots were scratched and the remaining 7 lots were unsold with reserve bids of \$133.00 live not being met.
