U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade was strong last week with most trade taking place on Tuesday and Wednesday ahead of the Thanksgiving holiday. Business in the south was from \$136.00-\$140.00 live, mainly \$138.00-\$140.00 up around \$5.00 cwt. Trade in the north ranged from \$210.00-\$220.00, majority at \$215.00-\$218.00 up \$6.00-\$8.00 cwt, with live trade reported at the same prices as southern deals. Overall prices for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price report saw live steers averaged \$138.17 up \$5.06 and heifers \$137.86 up \$4.47 from the previous week on average. On the rail steers averaged \$216.01 up \$6.41 with heifers \$216.53 up \$6.76.

Today the market was quiet as both sides took inventory. This week's offering is steady in volume in Texas and larger in Kansas and the northern feeding states. Bids and asking prices are currently unestablished.
