






AVERAGE CARCASS WEIGHTS - CANADA

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week saw the bulk of trade on Wednesday with just some clean up deals the remainder of the week. Business in the south was from \$136.00-\$138.00 live, mainly \$138.00 which is about steady to the previous week. Deals in the north were steady to slightly lower at \$138.00-\$140.00 live and \$218.00-\$220.00 dressed. Overall weighted averaged for the week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report, saw live steers average \$138.41 down \$1.18 with heifers \$138.09 down \$0.97. On the rail steers averaged \$219.98 down \$0.91 with heifers averaging \$219.99 down \$1.32.

Today, the market was quiet as new show lists were distributed. This week's offering is reported as smaller in Texas with all other feeding states having larger volumes to sell. Bids and asking prices are unestablished with little business expected before Wednesday. Agcenter.com notes: "The challenge and the focus of the meat packers will be slaughter volumes. Last week's slaughter was reported at 620,000 head — a disappointment to the entire industry — none more than cattle feeders who sensed a return to balance in the bargaining between cattle owners and processors. This number compares to 652,000 a year ago and far short of the need for balance. Packers attention will be focused on the labor force where absenteeism, covid quarantines, and late returns from the holidays prevented normalized slaughter along with some mechanical breakdowns at aging plants. The expectation is this week will bottom out the poor volumes and plants will be heading towards more normalized volumes. "
