ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains at a standstill with little business expected to develop today. Canfax notes that this week's offering is about steady to last week in volume. Canfax reports: "Packers have not been very active on the cash market over the past couple of weeks and sale volumes have been light. Fed prices have been disappointing relative to feedlot breakeven levels."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade last week, reported by the USDA Mandatory Price Report saw live steers average \$136.61 down \$1.80 from the previous week while heifers averaged \$136.49 live down \$1.60. On the rail, steers averaged \$217.99 dressed, down \$1.99 with heifers averaging \$217.89 down \$2.10 from the previous week's weighted average prices.

Today a light trade has surfaced with deals in the south at \$137.00 live, up \$1.00 cwt from last week's average, with business in the north at \$218.00 dressed, fully steady. Asking prices are holding firm at \$138.00 live in the south and \$220.00 dressed in the north.
