Alberta direct trade remains untested with little business expected to develop today. Canfax reports that this week's offering is steady to last week in volume with asking prices sitting around \$280.00 delivered on a dressed basis.

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade remains at a standstill with no bids on the table. Asking prices are slightly stronger in the south from \$139.00-\$140.00 live while the north remains unestablished. Another round of cattle futures moving slightly stronger along with increased production volumes week over week should lend some support to the cash market this week. Active trading is not expected to surface before Wednesday at the earliest.
