ALBERTA DIRECT TRADE

Alberta direct trade remains untested with business not expected to develop before the second half of the week. Canfax reports: "This week's showlist has been compiled with volumes smaller than the previous week. There have been numerous reports over the past couple of days that packers are 2-4 weeks behind schedule picking cattle up. Cattle that were supposed to be shipped out during the second half of January are still in the pen and these cattle are getting big. Western Canadian steer carcass weights averaged 922lbs, for the beginning of February this is the second largest carcass weight on record."

U.S. TRADE (U.S. funds)

The U.S. cash cattle trade is at a standstill with business not expected to develop before Wednesday. A couple of bids in Nebraska were noted today at \$223.00 dressed but no selling interest surfaced. All other feeding states were quiet with no bids on the table. Asking prices in the south are reported at \$142.00-\$143.00 live while the north is still undefined.
